

# The 8th INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON X-RAY MICROSCOPY



The X-ray microscopy conference held every three years is the primary international forum for the presentation and discussion of advances in high spatial resolution X-ray imaging and its applications across a broad range of science and technology.

The aim of the conference is to provide up-to-date information on the developments on X-ray microscopy, including basic X-ray physics and technology, and applications to biology, medicine, material science, chemistry, environmental science, and industry. The conference will also open the door to all the new methods for observing microstructures using X-rays as a probe, including theoretical approaches.

The 8th conference of this series, XRM2005, will be held at Himeji City, Japan in July 2005 with the support of SPring-8, University of Hyogo, and Himeji City.
